

Prof. Roberta Cimmaruta

Curriculum vitae

Roberta Cimmaruta is associate professor at the Department of Ecological and Biological Sciences of Tuscia University (Viterbo, Italy) since November 2016, where she was formerly senior researcher since October 2000.

RC has carried on her researches over 30 years, concerning biodiversity structuring, evolution and conservation, investigated in a variety of organisms and environments using the approaches of Evolutionary Ecology and Population Genetics and, more recently, Beta-Diversity assessment.

A main research interest regards the genotype-environment relationships, paying attention to the effects that the variation of the main environmental parameters may have on the genetic structure of fish in marine and brackish water environments. The target species for these studies is the cyprinodont fish *Aphanius fasciatus*, whose gene pool is under study since 1998 together with the strong environmental variation of the hyperhaline habitat of the Tarquinia Salterns (Central Tyrrhenian Sea).

Molecular approaches have been also used to investigate broad topics in evolutionary ecology: phylogenetic relationships between closely related species, phylogeography, population structure, paleo-biogeography, adding to the comprehension of the evolutionary process underlying extant patterns of genetic diversity throughout Europe, with particular regard to the role of both hybridization and glacial refugia in amphibians. A particular focus has been devoted to plethodontid salamanders of the genus *Hydromantes*, characterized by a peculiar evolutionary history due to their naturally fragmented habitat (caves) and the very small population size.

Another research field involves problems concerning sustainable fishery management within the frame of a multidisciplinary ("holistic") approach to fish stock identification and assessment, with particular attention to the relationships between the population genetic structure of exploited fish and the fishing effort. The host-parasite system represented by commercially harvested fish and the Anisakid nematode endoparasites has been studied to investigate the relationships between the genetic variability of the host and its susceptibility. More recently this kind of research has taken into consideration fish-parasite systems from the pristine habitat of Antarctica investigating the genetic variation of the MCH system of the icefish *Chionodraco hamatus*.

In recent years, the research activity of Roberta Cimmaruta has been addressed to the population and community spatial structure in marine coastal habitats (*Posidonia oceanica* meadows), with the objective of merging the approaches of ecological genetics with those typical of meta-community structure.

Roberta Cimmaruta has been appointed as the Italian "National Focal Point on Aquatic Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture at FAO in 2016.

The researches of Roberta Cimmaruta produced more than 50 peer reviewed papers, a chapter of a university textbook and the co-authorship of two monographies. Roberta Cimmaruta has a Scopus and WOS-based h-index of 16 counting 848 citations and a Google Scholar h index of 19 counting 1399 citations.

Roberta Cimmaruta is in the Editorial Board of PlosOne and has reviewed manuscripts for over 20 scientific journals, including Molecular Ecology, Diversity, Global Change Biology, and Transactions of the American Fishery Society.

Roberta Cimmaruta has been the supervisor of the PhD school in "Ecology and Sustainable Management of Environmental Resources" at the Department of Ecological and Biological Sciences of Tuscia University between 2017-2020 and 2010-2014. She teaches "Biodiversity Conservation" and "Ecology" for Biology

course and "Marine Biodiversity Conservation" for the high course in Marine Biology and Ecology at the Department of Ecological and Biological Sciences of Tuscia University.

Many of the researches of Roberta Cimmaruta were framed within research projects funded at both Italian and European level, with RC involved as Principal Investigator or head of Research Unit. Among the others, she has been involved in EU QL 1438-HOMSIR, EU FIRE 97-3494-GENHAKE, EU CFP 96/C75-TONGEN, three EU LIFE NATURA and two MIPAAF (Italian Ministry for Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries) projects on coastal management and conservation, three PRNA projects (Italian Antarctic Research Program, PNRA2013 AZ/109, PRNA 2016_00279-A1), an Intergovernmental S & T Cooperation Programme between Italy and Hungary on the "Development and application of statistical and mathematical tools to address sustainable fishery management". Roberta Cimmaruta has recently be the Principal Investigator of an Italian research project on "Submerged artificial reefs and restocking in Marine protected area of Northern Latium (Tyrrhenian Sea)" co-founded by EU-FEAMP funds.
